

Thank you for your letter received Monday 18 February outlining your concerns regarding the development of the Stable Fly Management Plan. Thank you also for the information you provided.

I can advise that the second draft of the Stable Fly Management Plan is nearly complete; after which it requires approval from the Reference Group and State Government.

Stable fly breeding can only be controlled through coordinated effort and support from industry, landowners, local Government and State Government agencies, principally the Department of Agriculture and Food (DAFWA).

If the Nationals WA retain the balance of power following the upcoming State Election, I will ensure the Stable Fly Management Plan's timely completion and that all necessary resources are committed to implementing the plan. I can assure you that I am taking your concerns seriously and will continue to work hard to complete and implement the plan to resolve this critical issue.

I would be happy to meet with your organisation following the March election to discuss the issues you raise in more detail.
